GENERAL INFORMATION

The minimum age requirement to be on Camp Staff is 15 years of age by June 1. Applicants must be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America as a Scout, Venturer, or adult or agree to become registered before employment may be offered. The Boy Scout Eagle Rank or Venturing Silver Award are important factors in Camp Staff Selection for those under 18. The principles of the Scout Oath and Scout Law must be practiced as a way of life. The staff sets an example of excellence in Scouting which includes the proper wearing of the uniform. Staff members agree to report on time for training and remain until the session ends. Staff members are required to reside in housing provided by the Illowa Council. Proof of citizenship will be required at time of employment.
