PROGRAM: Scouting Skills to support Mystery, Mayhem & Meriment in the DEAD of NIGHT, in pursuit of your Mission.

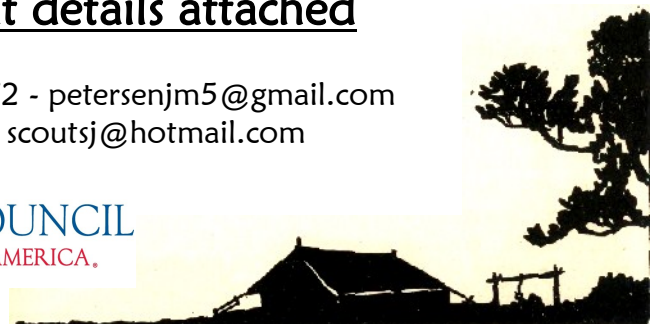
FEES: \$8 or (\$5 if paid by Sept 23rd).

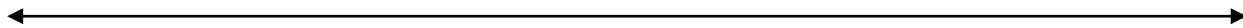

The Illowa Council Camporee will be held October 8th and 9th at Camp Loud Thunder.
The Camporee timeline:

October 8th - Saturday

2:00pm Registration Opens – at camp Loud Thunder
1-4pm Unit Arrival & Camp Set Up
4-7pm Dinner, Clean Up & Wide Area Game – per Troop
7-7:30pm Mission Briefing – at Campfire Ring
7:30pm Start First Assigned Mission - by Patrol
10:00pm Jaws of Death Mission
10:45pm Continue Missions by patrol
12:30am Missions close
12:45am Patrols return to campsite & Lights Out

October 9th – Sunday

Reveille & breakfast at campsite – per Troop
10:30am – Camp-wide Vespers (brief & non-denominational)
Closing Ceremony – award Program
Break Camp
Noon – Done and checked-out

Every participant, observer, or anyone just walking by the camp (adult and youth) must bring an up-to-date health form to present upon registration (Forms can be downloaded at the Council website).

Missions may include (but are not limited to):

- ◆ Laser Gauntlet
- ◆ Blind Escape
- ◆ Espionage Adventure
- ◆ Enemy Encampment
- ◆ Agent Rescue
- ◆ Signal the Sub
- ◆ Stealth Hike
- ◆ Star Trek
- ◆ Jaws of Death

Each Patrol will be required to have the following: 8 agents(Scouts), personal flashlights with light covered by red cellophane, 2 copies of the patrol roster and at two deep leadership with each patrol.

Event Details... continued

- ◆ Safety is the most important part of the Camporee!
- ◆ The BSA “Buddy System” will be the rule of the camp & enforced during the Camporee – please prepare your agents.
- ◆ Registration for this event is limited to Boy Scouts.
- ◆ Units can camp Friday night but the Camporee staff will not be arriving until noon on Saturday. Please contact Jeremy Snook at (563)388-7233 for camping location information or you may be moved on Saturday evening.
- ◆ Each patrol must be accompanied by two observers - two deep leadership (adults to be furnished by their unit) during the evening missions.
- ◆ Patrols will be given secret orders that will direct them to their starting mission.
- ◆ Patrols will be issued a special invitation (starting time) for STAR TREK.
- ◆ Patrols may complete the missions in the most expedient order.
- ◆ Smaller Patrols may be combined into larger patrols as needed.
- ◆ Units should target 8 agents per patrol.
- ◆ Every Patrol must do a “buddy check” before and after every mission.
- ◆ Mission Leaders will do a buddy check with every patrol on mission check-in.
- ◆ Patrols will not be allowed to compete if they fail a “Buddy Check.”
- ◆ More safety instruction will be provided at check-in.
- ◆ Red cellophane for flashlight covers will be provided to all participants.
- ◆ For the Jaws of Death Mission – any participant with a food allergy concern should bring their own “Jaws of Death” snack.
- ◆ No white light will be allowed at Loud Thunder during the night mission.
