

HALT Q & A

Q. Does everyone that attends need to pay?

A. Yes. We need to know everybody that is at camp, so they need to register. We have to insure everyone.

Q. Can I pay at the event?

A. Yes. The price will be \$12.00 per person.

Q. The price is \$10.00 per person if paid by September 30th

A. This includes camping, 2 hot meals, a patch, a bag of candy, an evening program, midway, hay rack ride, haunted house, and prizes for the kids. You do not have to camp, but the price is the same either way.

Q. Can I bring a pet?

A. No. There are wild animals at camp. We have had problems with noisy animals keeping people up at night.

Q. Will there be campfires?

A. Camp fires will be permitted in the existing fire rings WEATHER PERMITTING! The Camp Ranger will make the decision, and it will be final.

Q. Can I bring my own food to camp?

A. You will be using your own tent, so you could. We are providing hot meals for you, as well as a Trading Post.. Raccoons and other wild animals can (and will) get into tents with food in them.

Q. Can I smoke?

A. Smoking is prohibited at Scout Camp.

Q. Do I have to buy a shirt?

A. No, they are optional but if you want one we prefer you pre-order them by September 30th to make sure we will have one in your size.
