Saturday, February 2, 2012 will be the date of the **11th** Illowa Council First Aid Merit Badge Clinic hosted by the Council's Enterprise Risk Management Committee at Genesis East Hospital in Davenport, Iowa. This year we are also adding the option for Scouts to take the NEW Search and Rescue Merit Badge. Scouts can sign up for one clinic, either First Aid Merit Badge or Search and Rescue Merit Badge.

- There will be an opportunity for the First Aid Merit Badge Students to see state of the art first aid and resuscitation equipment. The Instructors will be EMTs, nurses, and physicians for this top notch clinic.
- There will be an opportunity for the Search and Rescue Merit Badge Student to work with local EMTs, and learn more about specific Search and Rescue Efforts in the Quad Cities.
- This is an opportunity and learning experience difficult to recreate in a troop.

ALL Scouts should have read and reviewed the merit badge book in order to pass a written exam at the end of the day. It is also recommended Scouts have achieved Tenderfoot Rank or higher for the First Aid Merit Badge Clinic, and First Class rank or higher for the Search and Rescue Merit Badge Clinic.

The merit badge clinics will be from 9:00 a.m. (registration from 8:30 until 9:00) until approximately 3:30 p.m. and Scouts should bring a bag lunch and water. First Aid Merit Badge Scouts should also bring their assembled first aid kit. The Clinics include a patch and light snacks. Registration is only \$10 per scout if paid by January 21st, and \$20 after that date. SPACE IS LIMITED, if the clinic fills, no late registrations will be accepted.
