Klondike Derby 2012

Klondike derby is an annual event held for Webelos and Boy Scouts during the winter months. The event consists of a series of stations where patrols test their skills and leadership abilities, earning points towards a total score. This year's stations include:

Compass, Knots/Lashings/Teamwork, Fire, First Aid, Leave No Trace, Nature, Wilderness Survival and Modern/High-tech sled.

- Webelos may compete on their own or with a Troop.
- A team that consists of only Webelos will need a 5:1 Scout to adult ratio.
- Each patrol should bring a patrol flag embellished with this year's theme.
- Patrol leaders must introduce themselves and members of their patrol to the station judge to include Patrol and Troop name/number.
- Extra credit will be given for modern/high tech (sleds made of any materials).
- Lunch will be from 11:30 A.M. – 1:00 P.M. Cook a warm meal for you and your judges.
- Overnight camping is optional on Friday night. Patrols that camp the night before will receive a mulligan for their lowest score. To receive the mulligan 100% of the patrols Boy Scout aged youth must camp overnight. Webelos are encouraged to come out the next morning. This option not available for those competing in the Webelos division.
- There must be one Scout in the sled at all times of travel during the derby.

Equipment List

1. Sled with attached towing bridle, must have runner and Troop/Pack numbers
2. Six ropes, each at least 6' long
3. Patrol first-aid kit
4. Compass
5. 1 Scout handbook
6. Patrol Flag made by the patrol with this year's theme
7. Pencil, notebook, pocketknife, Totin' chip card
8. List of boys in the patrol that day (name and rank)
9. One blanket
10. Tarp (big enough for the patrol) 9'x9'
11. Food and water, enough for patrol and two judges
12. Eating utensils for all members of the patrol and the judges.
13. Twine or rope
14. Hot spark, Must know how to use it properly. Points deducted if matches are used.
15. Scouts dressed for the weather
16. Three 5' poles
17. Trail food (Optional)
18. Some way to keep equipment and one Scout in the sled

ANY PERSON NOT PROPERLY DRESSED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO GO ON THE TRAIL

Each Scout and adult must have the following equipment:

1. Warm cloths, dressed in layers (bring face protection)
2. Proper footwear (No tennis shoes)
3. Water for drinking
4. Appropriate camping gear to stay warm and dry if camping overnight.

Remember leave no trace! Pack it in...Pack it out.
