The Outdoor Leader Skills (OLS) course is an intensive overnight course with instruction and practice in the outdoor skills important in Scouting. You should attend if:

- You're a Scoutmaster, Asst. Scoutmaster or transferring Webelos Leader**
- You work with Scouts or Venturers in the outdoors**
- You are planning to lead Scout camping events**

OLS is the Outdoor training session required to be fully trained as Troop Assistant or a Scoutmaster. (The other two courses required to be fully trained are This is Scouting and BS Leader Specifics.)

Friday & Saturday, April 13-14, 2012

@ Loud Thunder Scout Resevation (A NON-SMOKING Facility)

Cost: \$15.00 per participant, which includes all materials for the course and Saturday meals (Friday evening meal is not provided)
Registration must be received on or before April 6, 2012. Course size is limited to 25 participants and a minimum of 15 is required to hold course.

Times: Course begins with registration at 6:00PM on Friday evening and will conclude approximately 8:00PM Saturday evening. Camping is required!
 Set up time begins at 5PM on Friday.

What to Bring: Participants will need to bring their Scout Physical (*parts A&B*) a tent, sleeping gear, their personal overnight supplies and eating utensils.
(Group cooking gear will be provided)
