


In order to create your MyScouting account, browse to <http://myscouting.scouting.org/> and click on the link in located in the New to MyScouting box.

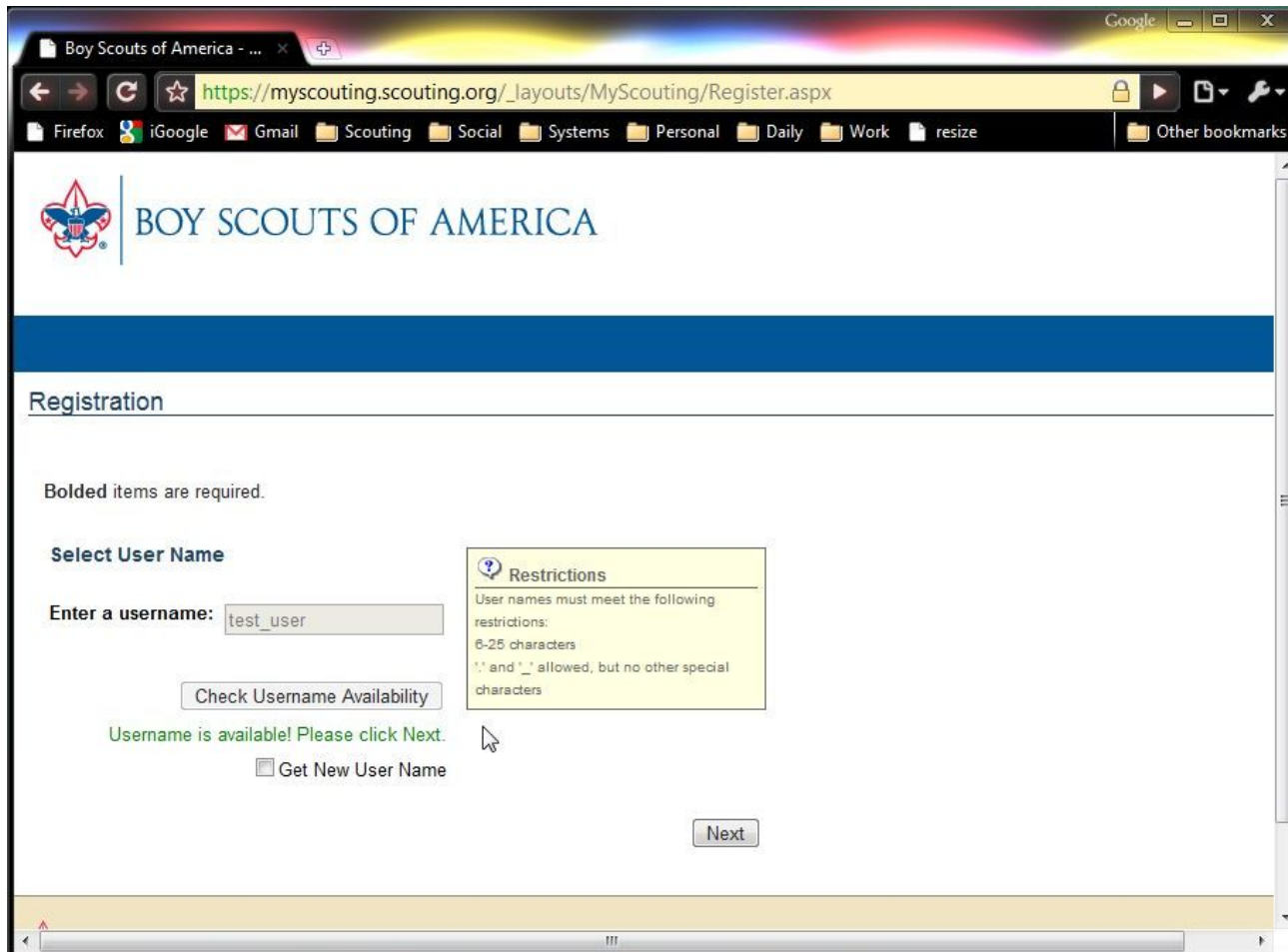

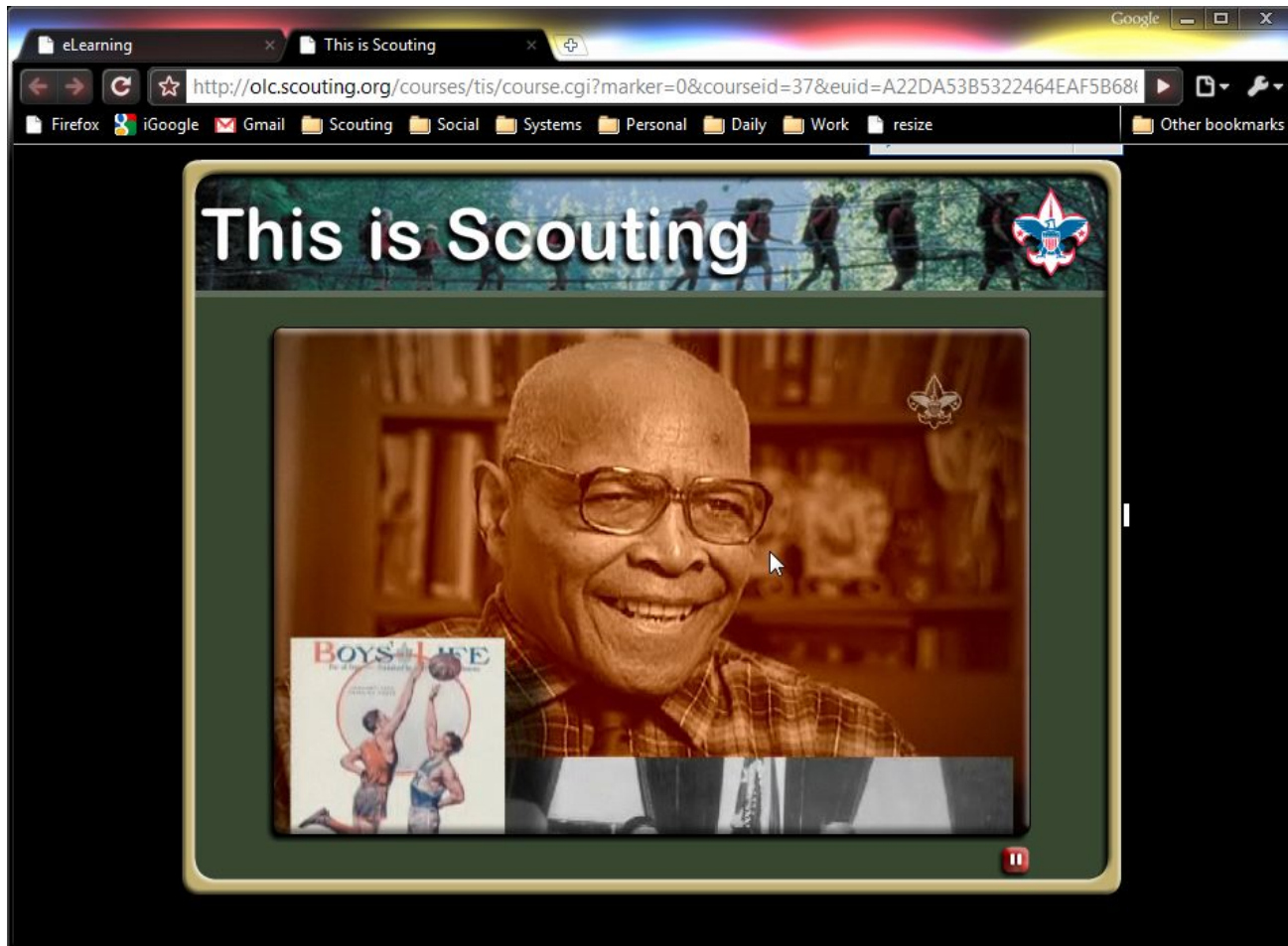
