## Saukenuk Achieves Quality District

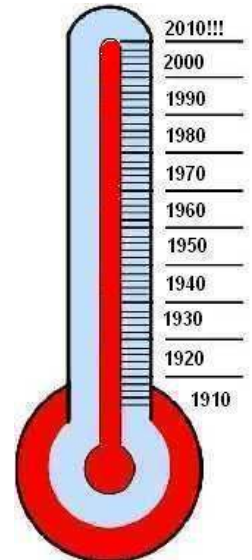

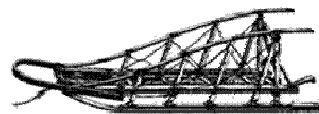
